## Documents

To make the application process easier, make sure to have the following at your fingertips:

- \* Paycheck stubs for one month
- \* Unemployment stubs & documents
- \* SSI/SSDI Documentation
- \* Federal Tax Return or 4506T completed form (most current year)
- \* Bank/Asset Documentation
- \* Food Stamp Award Letter
- \* Temporary Cash Assistance

## TIPS FOR SAVING ON MEDICATIONS:

- \* Let your doctor help you save. Your doctor knows which medications are right for you but may not know the cost for you individually. Discuss options; including generic versus brand name medications.
- \* Ask local pharmacies if they offer special prices on certain meds. Often discounts are available but they must be requested.
- \* Be your own advocate! Don't be afraid to ask questions and try to find solutions that are best for you and your family.
