

**CARROLL COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT (CCHD)
H1N1 (SWINE FLU) VACCINATION CLINIC SCHEDULE**

These clinics are open to the general population age 6 months and older. Those individuals in the target groups are still highly encouraged to receive the vaccine as they are at higher risk for complications from H1N1. The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) priority groups are:

- Pregnant women
- Household contacts and caregivers for children younger than 6 months of age
- Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel
- Children and young adults aged 6 months to 24 years
- Persons aged 25 through 64 with health conditions that place them at greater risk of medical complications from influenza

Given the "sporadic" level of H1N1 flu activity in Maryland and surrounding states as well as the decrease in the local demand for H1N1 vaccine, the Health Department has scheduled their last evening clinic (March 18) and the last Saturday clinic (March 27) for H1N1 vaccinations. Keep in mind that this schedule may be revised if there is any change from the current H1N1 flu activity level and/or an increase in demand for the H1N1 vaccine. Please remember, it is STILL important to receive your H1N1 vaccination. H1N1 flu remains active in the community.

Remember, we cannot vaccinate children younger than 6 months of age. It is important to note that children 9 years of age and under need to receive a 2nd dose of H1N1 vaccine 4 weeks or 28 days after their 1st dose. If it has been longer than 4 weeks or 28 days since your child's first dose, this is NOT an issue. However, it is still recommended that children 9 years of age and younger DO receive a 2nd dose of the H1N1 vaccine. The H1N1 vaccine is FREE and anyone who would like the vaccine, over the age of 6 months, is able to attend the clinic.
