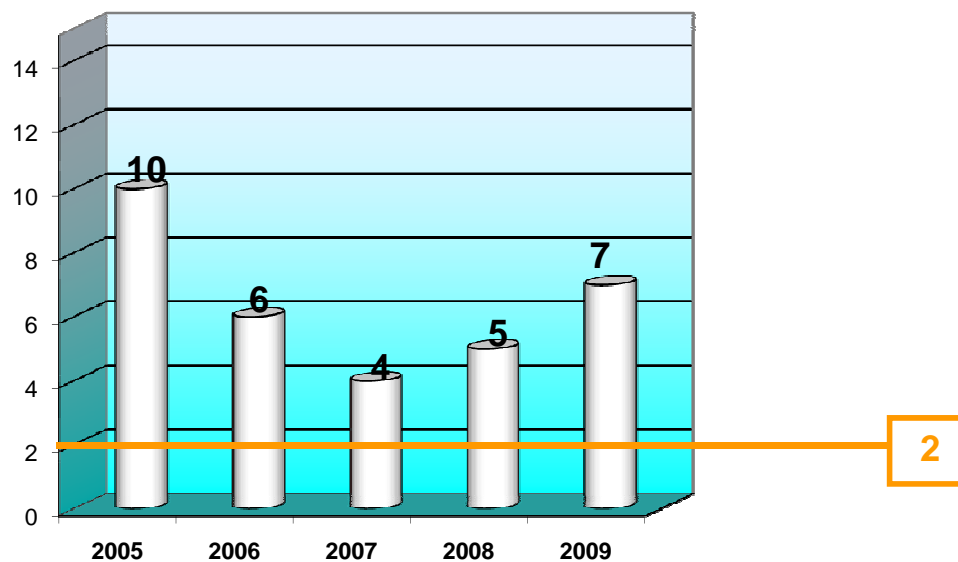

Improvement Objective: 2 or less per year



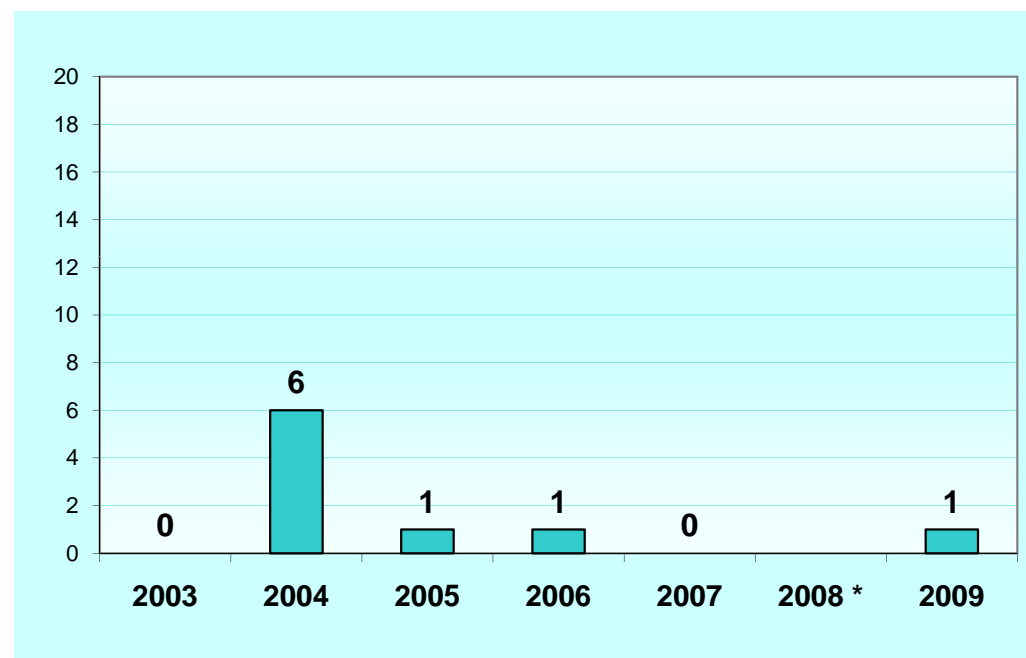

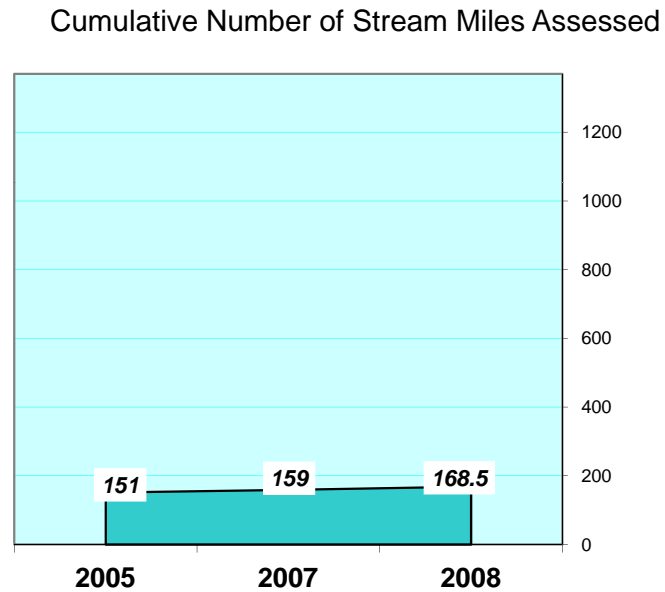
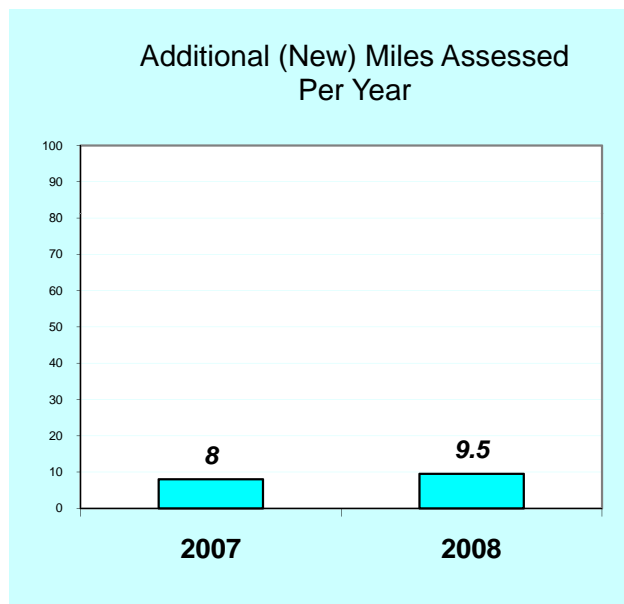

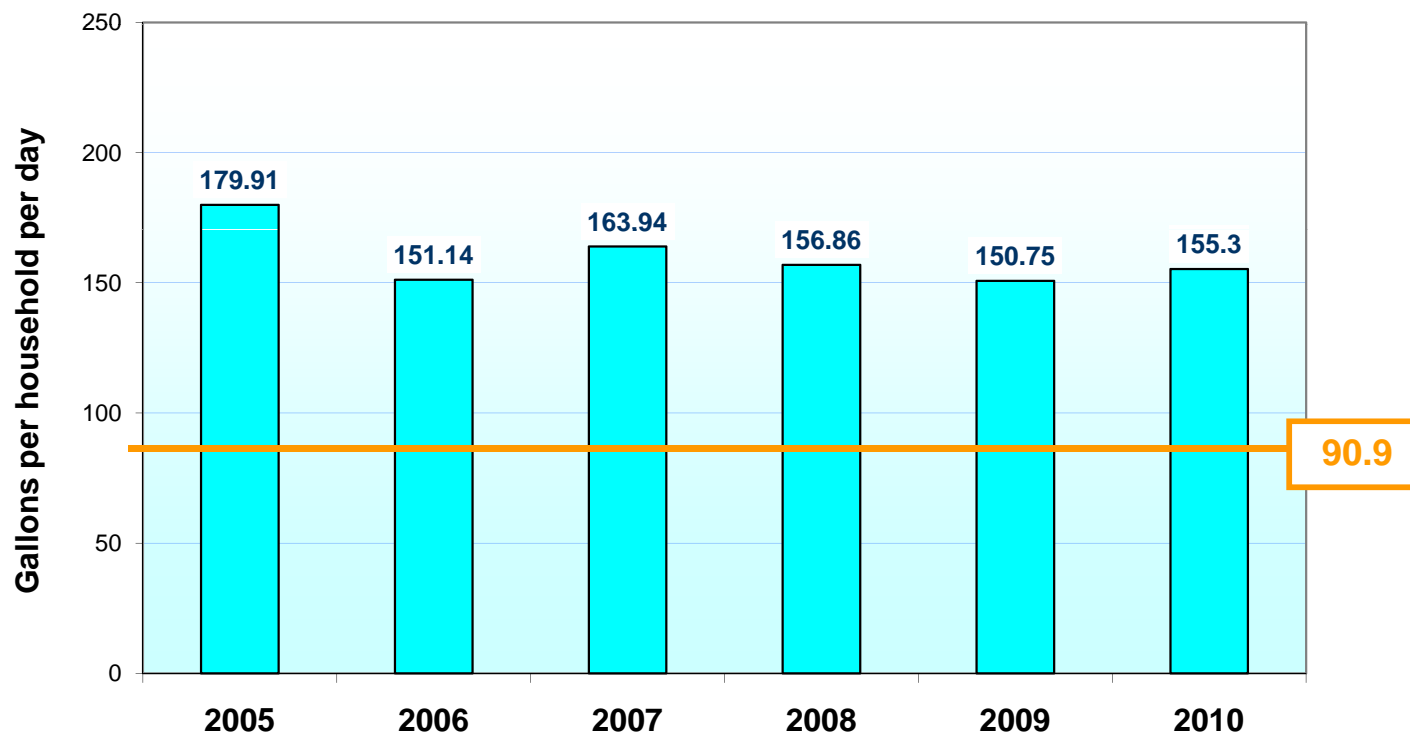
