The Cigarette Restitution Fund Program at Carroll County Health Department is seeking high school students to serve as student representatives on our Community Tobacco Coalition.

### **Requirements:**

- Attend at least 3 Community Tobacco Coalition meetings.
- Design and implement an educational program to teach other students about the dangers of non-cigarette tobacco products such as Snus, smokeless tobacco, cigars or hookahs. This could be in the form of a bulletin board, presentation to a health class, or lunch mod activity. Training, materials and assistance will be provided by the health department.

Gain experience as a community advocate (looks great on your resume).  
Network with community leaders. Prevent tobacco use among your peers.  
Students would be eligible to earn 50 Service Learning Hours
